


MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTDING On INTER UNIVERSITY CONSORTIUM FOR THE PROMOTION OF SOCIAL SCIENCES, ARTS & HUMANITIES



The following Higher Education Institutes (HEIs) hereby agree to form a consortium for the promotion of Social Sciences, Arts and Humanities:

- 4. Shah Abdul Latif University Khairpur
- 5. University of Baluchistan Quetta
- 6. Institute of Managements Sciences Peshawar
- 7. Bahauddin Zakariya University Multan
- 8. The Islamia University of Bahawalpur



- Faculty Development/Exchange as Adjunct Faculty Members
- Exchange of students & scholars
- Joint research projects (Each university would work in its respective geographical area)
- Joint linkages with other international & national organizations
- Joint seminars/conferences & workshops and miscellaneous academic/co-curricular activities
- Sharing of facilities/expertise among the consortium members
- Diploma/Certificate Courses on Civic/Human Rights Education and other important issues.
- Other programs of mutual interest

The terms of such mutual assistance and cooperation shall be discussed and agreed upon by the responsible authority of each university prior to the initiation of any particular programme or activity. This agreement shall take effect upon the approval of all parties and shall remain in effect for an initial period of five years.
